We are working to set up a Project Registry with Lowe's or Home Depot. Until that is setup, please check with our office regarding the tool/tools you would like to provide. ngoplen@lcsnw.org or call 503-731-9519 and leave a message.

Types of tools needed are:

Layout and measuring tools: 100 foot tape measure; 25 foot tape measures; Framing squares; Speed Square; 6' Level; 4' Level; Plumb bob; Chalk Box; Carpenter's pencils;

Safety items: Goggles; Paper masks; Sanitary hand wash; toweling; flares; traffic cones; First Aid Kit;

Cutting tools: "Skilsaw"; 12" compound miter saw, (or a 10" sliding compound miter) with stand; Saw horses; planks; Sawsall; ½" drill w/bits; All cutting tools should have carbide blades; hacksaw; handsaw;

Driving tools: Framing hammers 20 oz minimum; claw hammers 16 oz; Roofing hammers; Nail aprons; 6 lb sledge hammer; Cats paw or short wrecking bars; Drills, corded and cordless/reversible;

Power source: Generator 5500 Watt; Generator 8 hp; Heavy extension cords with multiple outlets; 100' heavy duty electric cord with winder. (We will not be using pneumatic nailers unless a worker brings them. We want to be sure that users are skilled and safety conscious.)

Other items: Ladders; Ladder Jacks; Jacks; Staple tackers; Utility knives; Caulking guns; Hoses; Paint trays, rollers, and brushes; Rakes, Shovels, Patio brooms; Pliers, Screwdrivers; Wheel barrow; large Tool Box for small items; 1 Quart and 5 gallon buckets; Stud finder; Staplers; Clamps; Knee pads; 10x10 canopy; Moisture Meter; Fire Extinguisher; Industrial flashlight; Spare Tire with cover Tiedown straps rubber; Bungie cords; Trash Bags; Wet/Dry Vacuum; Water Hose with nozzle; Worklight with stand 500 Watt;
